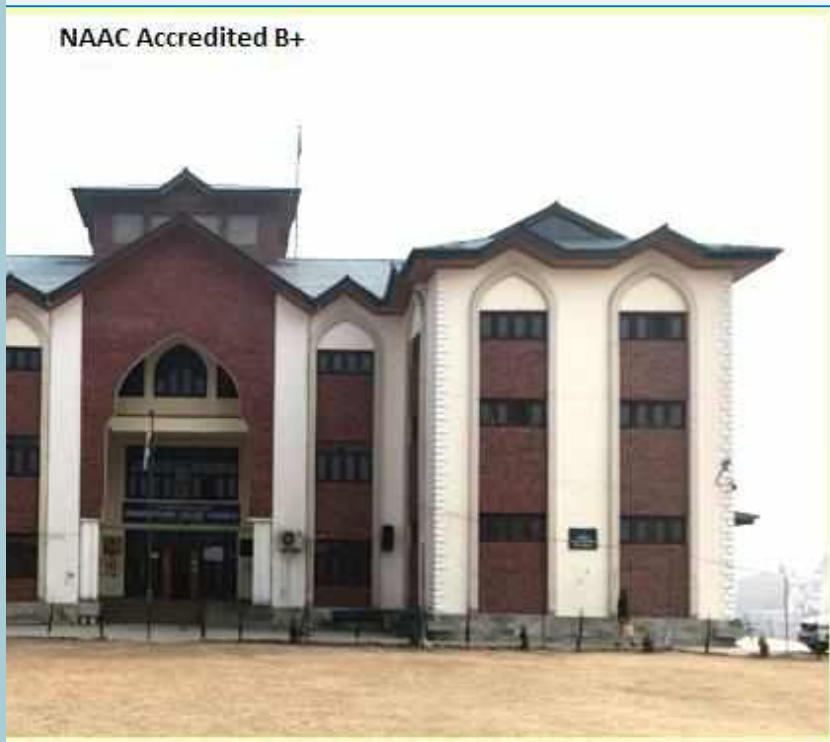

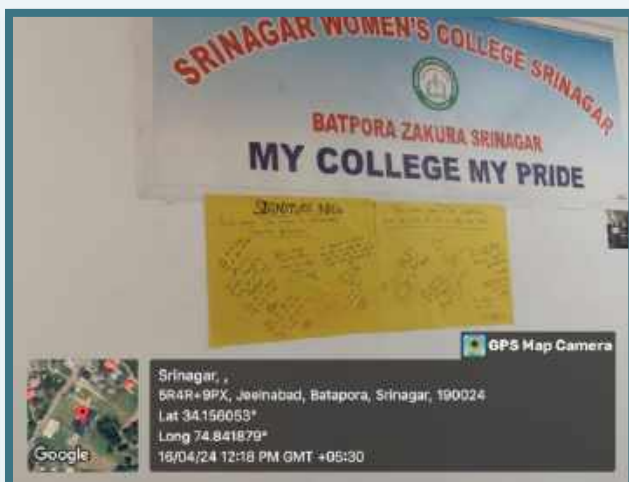

Painting and Slogan writing competition

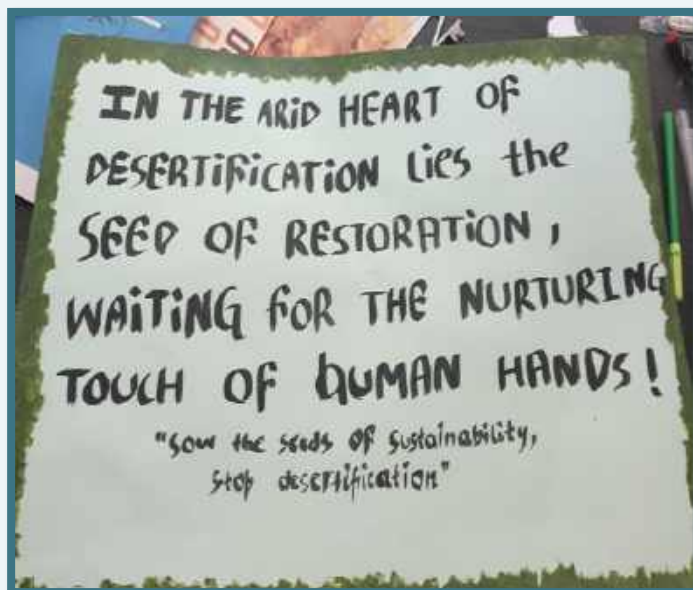

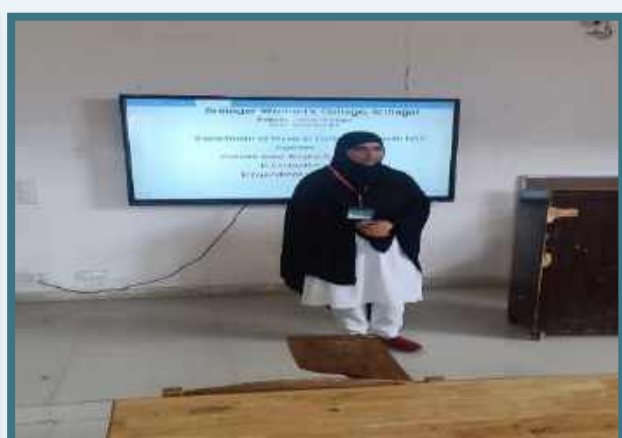
The collaborative efforts of the NSS and the Debates and Seminars Committee ensured the event's success, leaving a lasting impact on the participants and the college community.

2. Candlelight Vigil:

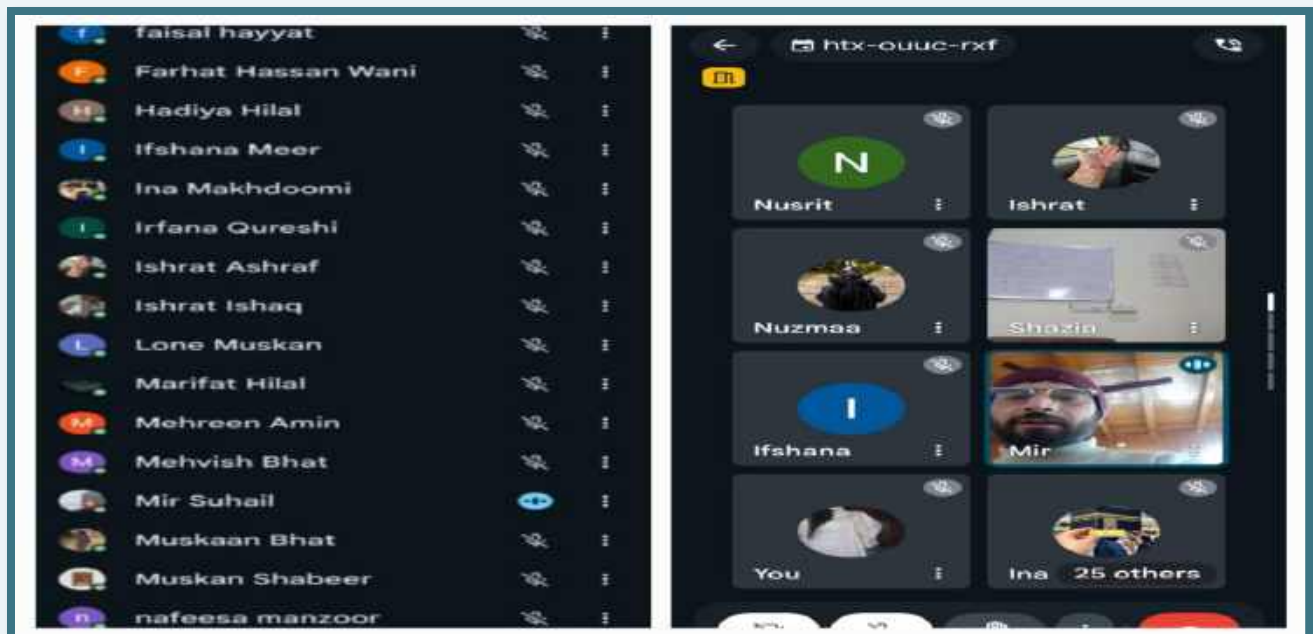
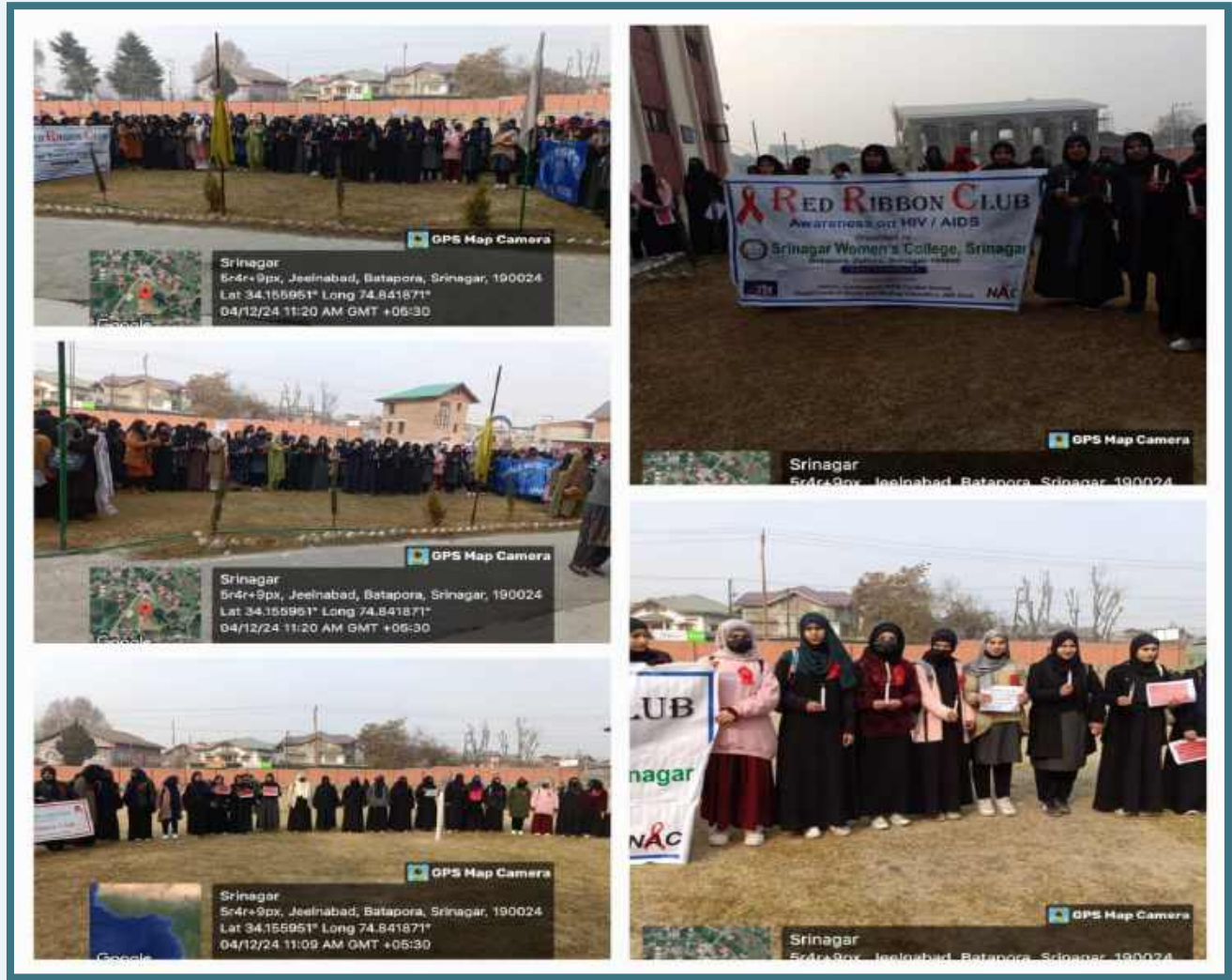
- Attended by 100 students along with the Principal, faculty, and staff.

Visit to the Department of Archives on the Eve of World Heritage Day

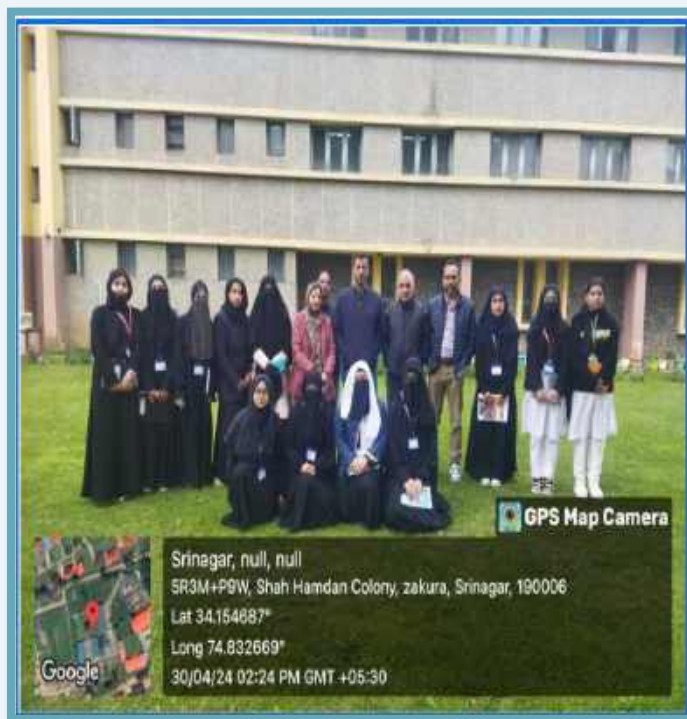

Dr Bhabha established the Tata Institute of Fundamental Research (TIFR) for carrying out nuclear science research in 1945. To intensify the effort to exploit nuclear energy for the benefit of the nation, Dr Bhabha established the Atomic Energy Establishment, Trombay (AEET) in January 1954 for multidisciplinary research program essential for the ambitious nuclear program of India.

After the sad demise of Bhabha in 1966, AEET was renamed Bhabha Atomic Research Centre (BARC). At the end, HOD Physics, SWC Zakura Prof. Shehzada Parveen, presented vote of thanks to the BARC team.



Historical Tour to Naranag Temples
